It is a revision tool and one to two pages a day could be completed.</li><li>• Counting games from 1 - 20, counting backwards and forwards, skipping numbers and simple counting rhymes are other suggested activities.</li></ul>
<b>Literacy</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Continue practise with the sight word list and sounds. The copies are in Book Bags or see Jolly Phonics group 1, 2 and 3.</li><li>• Read as much as possible, talking about the story, predictions for the story and retelling the story.</li></ul>
